REGULATIONS REGARDING DRESS CODE

ON COURT

It is required that at all times members should wear recognised tennis clothing when on court. When playing on grass, the Club wish to continue to encourage members to wear something predominantly white but will accept recognised tennis clothing. However, the Club reserve the right to refuse entry on grass court to anybody not suitably attired including specifically any person not wearing recognised tennis footwear with predominantly flat soles.

IN THE BAR

It is requested that waterproof clothing and all headgear should be removed.

It is also requested that members do not wear Aerobic Leotards in this area.

ON THE PREMISES GENERALLY

For Males Sleeveless tops (i.e. vests) are strictly prohibited.

For All Denims are accepted along with t-shirts and football shirts, but they must be smart and tidy. Trainers/tennis shoes must be clean.

THE COURT ALLOCATION BOARD SYSTEM

- No booking in any form will be acceptable before 9.30 am *at which time the board will be wiped clean.*
- Before going on court, players must consult the board for availability before allocating themselves a court.
- After choosing a court, players must write their names in the corresponding court number and time slot.
- Players may use the court for a 1½ hour period.
- On vacating the court after the 1½ hour period, players may write their names on another time slot. (players may keep the same court if it has not been reserved by other parties. however, names must be written accordingly)
- Players may only reserve courts on the day of play by personal visit to the club from 9.30 am onwards. however, for grass courts only, members may telephone the club for reservations between 9.30 am and 10.00 am each day to reserve a grass court on the day in question only. *telephone bookings will not be taken at any other time.*
- Players may not reserve two different courts at any one time.
- Players must vacate their reserved court after 10 minutes of their allotted time if their opponents have not arrived and there are others waiting for a court.
- Adults may reserve courts on Sections 1, 2 and 3 – Junior may reserve courts on Section 4.

SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS - 2005

The Health & Safety Executive pays particular attention to swimming pools and the dangers associated with them. As a result of this, substantial investment was made several years ago to reduce the depth of the pool and to fence it.

Nevertheless, dangers still exist and as members of the Committee and especially the Manager could be held liable in the event of an accident, we must introduce more stringent rules.

The Club will aim to provide a trained Lifeguard whenever the pool is open, 12 noon to 6pm each day.

The pool will only be opened if a trained lifeguard is on duty. If no lifeguard is available, the pool gate will be locked and the pool closed to all users.

Children under the age of 8 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
The swimming pool is strictly out of bounds when the gates to the pool are locked.

The unacceptable practice of scaling the fence will result in disciplinary action.

No food or alcohol is to be consumed within the perimeter fence.

Persons under the influence of alcohol are forbidden from using the pool.

Any dangerous behaviour should be reported to a staff member, immediately.

No diving or bombing is allowed.

No running along the poolside.

No pushing into pool.

No piggybacks or shoulder fights.

Maximum 25 persons in the pool at any one time.

Recognised swimwear only.

No breakables or glass allowed within the perimeter fence.

Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Noon to 1pm - Exclusively over 50's
2pm to 3pm - Mothers and toddlers under 5yrs

Always use the swimming pool changing rooms

Guests are welcome to the pool at a cost of £5, reducing to £4 when accompanied by another member.
Fees are to be paid before swimming.

Please have an enjoyable time but be mindful of other users and of safety, generally
