CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries, together with the appropriate fees, must reach the Secretary by the FIRST POST on FRIDAY, 25th July 2008. Receipts will not be issued unless especially requested.
 2. The Tournament has been sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association and will be conducted in accordance with the Association's Rules and regulations, including the L.T.A. Code of Conduct.
 3. Competitors in Singles Events shall be members of the L.T.A. Registered Membership Scheme and have a Rating, except players in the 10 and under events.
 4. Subject to the Association's Regulations, the Committee reserve the right to adopt any or all of the following courses at their discretion, viz. to seed the draw, to modify the programme, to hold qualifying competitions, to divide an entry into classes, to cancel an event if less than 16 entries are received in the case of Singles and Doubles, to limit the number of events for which a player may enter and to accept late entries and as a result alter the draw.
 5. No player will be permitted to play in more than two age groups, and will be limited to a maximum of four events only. Only one Mixed Doubles event may be entered.
 6. AGE LIMITS:
18 and under events (Nos.1-4) for players born in 1990 or later.
16 and under events (Nos.6-9) for players born in 1992 or later.
14 and under events (Nos.11-14) for players born in 1994 or later.
12 and under events (Nos.15-19) for players born in 1996 or later.
10 and under events (Nos.20-21) for players born in 1998 or later.
 7. Competitors must give definite information regarding their "form". This is needed to assist in "seeding" and in arranging partners where required. The Committee will endeavour to arrange suitable partners for Doubles if asked to do so.
 8. **This list states the intended start times for events and is provided as a guide only. You should telephone the Referee on Sunday 10th August (between 2 – 5 p.m.) to confirm 1st match times. The number is as follows: 01255 674055.**
- the Saturday. All other age groups will be best of three tie-break sets.
9. The Slazenger ball will be used.
 10. 12 grass courts will be available and hard courts will be used at the discretion of the Referee.
 11. The Club stipulates that the CHALLENGE CUPS which are offered cannot be won outright and remain the Club's property in perpetuity. Appropriate prizes will also be awarded for each event.
 12. All members and guests should be wearing suitable tennis attire when playing on the grass and hard courts. This should comprise "recognised" tennis clothing and suitable flat soled tennis shoes. Clothing does not have to be white, although the Club would prefer to see a predominance of white. The following items are deemed unsuitable - Shirts with large, non-tennis logos, Sleeveless tops for men, Beach or running shorts, "Astro" turf training shoes with non-flat shoes.
 13. No complaint in connection with this Tournament can be entertained unless it is made in writing to the Tournament Director within 48 hours of the occurrence of the cause and no application for leave to appeal against the decision of the Committee can be entertained by the Council of the L.T.A. unless in writing and lodged with the Secretary of the Association within ten days of the receipt of the Committee's decision on the complaint.
 14. **Entries cannot be accepted from COMPETITORS WHO HAVE COMMITMENTS IN NATIONAL COMPETITIONS WHICH MAY CONFLICT WITH THIS TOURNAMENT.**
 15. PLATE EVENTS: Weather and time permitting, Singles competitions will be run from Thursday onwards for players who lose their first match. Competitors may enter one plate event only.
 16. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without reason.
 17. The Referee's decision is final.
